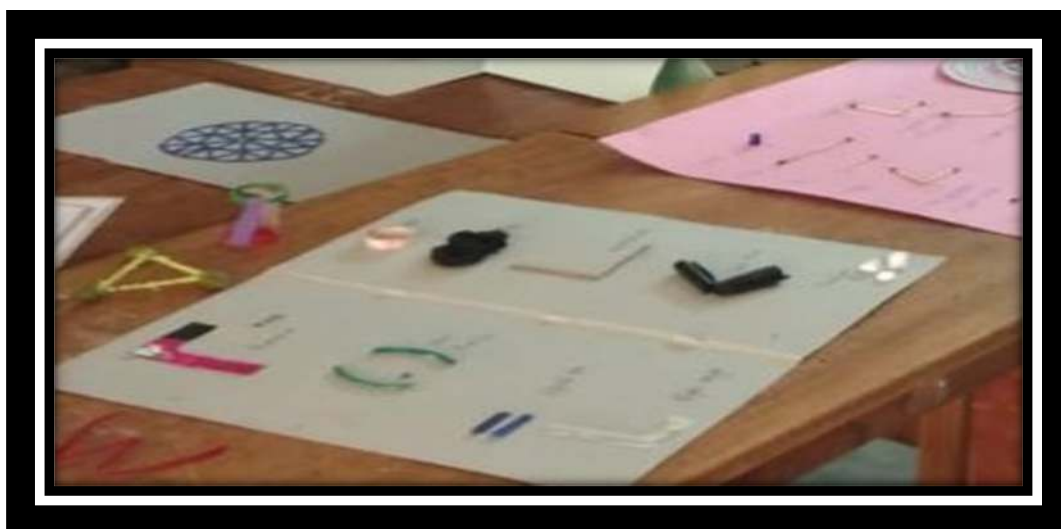
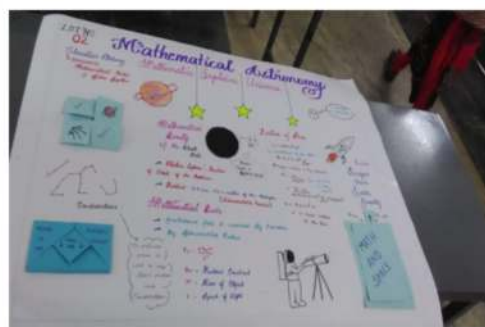
### **FUN WITH THE NUMBERS :**

The Death Anniversary of noted Mathematician Leonhard Euler (born April 15, 1707, Basel, Switzerland - died September 18, 1783, St. Petersburg, Russia) was celebrated on a grand scale in our college. Swiss Mathematician and physicist, one of the founders of Pure mathematics. He not only made decisive and formative contributions to the subjects of geometry, calculus, mechanics and number theory but also developed methods for solving problems in observational astronomy and demonstrated useful applications of mathematics in technology and public affairs.
