VILLAGE VISIT REPORT – KOMAPURAM

Every year, Students and Faculties of the Commerce Department visit some orphanages, old age homes, and physically & mentally challenged children's schools to help and to make them happy. In this academic year 2021-2022, we helped the Komapuram village people by giving awareness about higher education, health issues, dengue fever, cleanliness, use of technology, and social media. Komapuram is located near Gandharvakottai Taluk in the Pudukkottai district. It is almost 6 km away from Gandharvakottai and 28 km from Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women, Regunathapuram. Komapuram village itself is a Gram Panchayat and it has a total geographical area of 6 acres. In this village, there are about 2,500 people presently living in 700 houses. The village has few farmers and more laborers.

PURPOSE OF THE VISIT

To create awareness for the following:

- ➤ Girl child protection from social media
- ➤ Girls' Higher Education.

ACTIVITIES CARRIED OUT:

To extend our helping hands towards the Komapuram village, 47 students from the Commerce Department in Auxilium College visited the village along with 2 faculties: Assistant Professor Dr.S.Sumathi and Mrs.S.Juliet sellammal on 07.04.2022.

On 07.04.2022 (Thursday) at 10.30 AM we reached Komapuram village and met Mr.K.Anbu (councilor), Mr.Govindharaj, Mr.Kalimuthu, and Mr. Rengathurai who are noteworthy persons of the village. By accepting our request, they helped us to arrange the meeting with the people and also visit the Komapuram high school. Our Students eagerly participated in enacting the drama for girl child protection. The Komapuram high school headmaster Dr.Shanthi highly appreciated our college students for their efficient drama. She was very glad about the effort and shared her thoughts on girls' protection and girls' higher education.

- ❖ Our students enacted the drama for **girl child protection**.
- ❖ Increased the awareness of **girl child higher education**.
- ❖ Instructed people to avoid child labour and child marriage and explained punishments for those offenses.

PERSONAL EXPERIENCE OF OUR STUDENTS:

Students were asked many questions regarding the awareness of a girl child and her higher education.
