

Arockiya Deepa, visited the Bharathidasan University Library in Tiruchirappalli.</li> <li>The Bharathidasan University Library, established in February 1982, features various sections, including Stack, Reference, Circulation, Periodicals, Technical, Digital Library, Audio Visual Centre, and Reprography. Currently, the library houses approximately 95,000 volumes of books and back volumes in its stack. It subscribes to about 227 current national and international journals in print, covering a wide range of subjects to facilitate access to current academic and research literature. Additionally, the library offers online access to over 10,000 full-text journals and several databases of abstracting and indexing journals, as well as 8,500 Springer e-books across various subjects with perpetual access to enhance the quality of teaching and research activities.</li> <li>The library provides many convenient and modern services using ICT, both onsite and remotely, in response to user demand and proactively. It is automated using RFID technology and library automation systems like Koha. The library's welcoming environment and supportive staff ensure an optimal learning experience.</li> </ul>

Description	The Auxilium Institution Innovation Council organized an exposure visit to the ELITE Chocolate Museum & Factory in Kodaikanal on March 9th and 10th, 2024. The participants included six faculty members: Prof. Juliet, Prof. Deepa, Prof. Princiya, and Prof. Rajakumari, who are Institution Innovation Ambassadors, along with 51 students from the first, second, and third years. They commenced their visit at 12:30 am early on March 9th, 2024. Mr. Devaraj, an employee of the ELITE Chocolate Museum & Factory, provided insights into various operational aspects. He discussed the procurement of raw materials, the production process, by-products, marketing strategies, pricing, stock maintenance, safety rules, and the export process. Mr. Mohamed Shek, the Managing Director of the ELITE Chocolate Museum & Factory, detailed the process of making different varieties of chocolates, with a focus on standardization and the generation of power from these processes. The students participated with enthusiasm, gaining practical knowledge in production processes, cost management, and stock maintenance. To conclude the visit, all students received industrial visit certificates from Mr. Mohamed Shek, the Managing Director of the ELITE Chocolate Factory. This exposure visit inspired the students to consider starting their own micro, small, and medium enterprises for preparing homemade chocolates.
