## **INSTITUTION'S INNOVATION COUNCIL 5.0**

## ANNUAL ACTIVITY REPORT – 2022-2023

#### **ESTABLISHMENT:**

Our Institution established Auxilium Institution's Innovation Council in June 2022. This council carries out the calendar activities, celebration activities, MIC-driven activities and self-driven activities in every quarter. Moreover, we actively participated in 3<sup>rd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> quarter. It also performs the ATL school linkage programmes, and IA participation based on the guidelines from the Institution's Innovation Council. We have signed in MoU with Periyar Maniyammai Institute if Science and Technology for incubation Support. We have updated "National Innovation Startup Policy" and its action plan in NISP portal.

## IV QUARTER ACTIVITIES (June 2023 to Aug 2023)

- 1. The Auxilium Institution Innovation Council in collaboration with the Department of Commerce conducted a Lecture on 27 July 2023, with the theme "ACHIEVING VALUE PROPOSITION FIT& BUSINESS FIT". The Resource person Dr.G. Vigneshwaran, Assistant Professor and Associate Editor, TISSL International Publication, Trichy was warmly welcomed by Ms. A. Ayshwarya, the Association Leader of the Department. He was honored and felicitated by Dr.Sr.M.Sebasti Jeya Pushpam, Principal of Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women, in the presence of Sr.Dr.V. Santiagu Theresal, Vice Principal, IQAC Coordinator, Dr. M. Julie, Head and Assistant Professor of Commerce, Mrs. A. Anitha Janova, Assistant Professor in B.Com (CA) on the dais. The Resource Person sketched out his title systematically and innovatively, spurring and motivating the students how to attain designing great Value Propositions and become effective businesswomen in the future. 128 students benefited from this lecture. The event came to an end with a vote of thanks, thanking the resource person for his creative explanation.
- 2. 60 students and 10 Faculty members along with IIC Vice President Sr.Dr. V.Santiagu Theresal from Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women visited the incubation center at Periyar Maniyammai Institute of Science and Technology, Vallam on 2nd August 2023. Dr.Aruna, the Director of the Incubation Centre Explained the establishment, functions, and other activities of the Centre. She explained about herbal products, solar energy conservation, waste management, etc. She also emphasized on 3 "R"s, Reduce, Recycle, and Reuse. Then we

visited the Digital library, Robotics Science Centre, Audio Lab, and Multi-Media Centre unit and obtained knowledge. Students were given awareness of Vermicompost. This visit created more awareness and innovation among the students to be more creative innovators.

- 3. Pudukkottai Science Association Organized the 6<sup>th</sup> Book Festival from 28.07.2023 06.08.2023. We were invited by the organizers to participate in the Book Fest. So 113 students and 10 faculties along with the principal visited the book Exhibition on 05<sup>th</sup> August 2023. Students got an opportunity to buy a variety of books in a single place. The Exhibitors explained everything in a detailed manner. The principal purchased more than 100 books for the college library, such as competitive exam books, comic books, Moral stories, Tamil literature books, and Science books. It was an exposure visit to the students. It helped to develop student's reading skills and thirst for knowledge.
- 4. On 24.08.2023 an Expert talk on "Angel investment/VC Funding Opportunity for early stage Entrepreneurs" was organized by Auxilium Institution Innovation Council for the students of Auxilium College of Arts and Science for women at the media hall. It was also a great day for our institution as we welcomed our esteemed chief guest, Dr.A.P.ARUNA Chief Executive Officer, Periyar Technology Business Incubator Thanjavur has graciously accepted our invitation to share her thoughts, ideas and experience. In this programme, our chief guest explained elaborately the importance of innovative thinking in education to a nation's strength as well as an institution's strength. She gave her incredible speech on the title of Angel Investment/VC Funding Opportunity for early-stage Entrepreneurs. She shared about the meaning of innovation, the incubation Process, and the things that are in arts and science. And also talked about the water cane business and how it was developed in the market. She gave ideas to prove our solution, check varied conditions, build a prototype, test the market and refine/ modify expectations. About 78 faculty members benefitted from this programme. This session was very informative and useful.
- 5. Department of Computer Science and Computer Applications jointly organized an "Inter-Institutional Start-up Competitions "on August 29th, 2023 in Multipurpose Hall. On the whole there are 274 Students and 11 Faculty members are participated. The event was focused on vitalizing student entrepreneurs and providing support for the growth of placement. This event enhanced Students' entrepreneurial skills. Students showcased their ideas in several magnitudes by creating & developing new ventures of presenting PowerPoint, idea generating and poster making. Through this event, Students gained the theoretical and practical knowledge to be an effective entrepreneur.

- 6. The Department of Mathematics and Computer Applications organized a program on "Innovation & Entrepreneurship Outreach Program in Schools / Community" on 29th August 2023 for the students of Government Higher Secondary School at Regunathapuram, with the Guidance of IIC Vice President Dr. Sr. V.Santiagu Theresal. Ms. V. Surya, and Ms. S. Priyanka the programme coordinators executed this event. The main objective of the program is to create awareness among students about the Atal Tinkering Lab. The participants were from higher secondary first year and Second year Students. They gained knowledge about the basic concept of the Atal Tinkering Lab.
- 7. Celebrating the 3 years of Implementation of NEP 2020 among all students, and faculty, the MoE's Innovation Cell organized a Short Video Competition on the topic NEP Ki Samajh 2020 on 14 July, 2023. The Auxilium Institution Innovation Council motivated 43 students to prepare a short video on the significance of NEP 2020, answering any three questions among 11. There were 40 videos were prepared and uploaded as per the requirement of IIC. The videos were posted on Facebook, Twitter, Instagram and YouTube. The students were happy to contribute their creativity to raising awareness about the Student- Centric aspects of NEP. It was an excellent opportunity for students to showcase their talents and make a positive impact.
- 8. The Ministry of Education, Govt.of India had organized a mega event to Celebrate 3rd Anniversary of National Education Policy 2020 and the second edition of the Akhil Bhartiya Shiksha Samagam from 29th to 30th July 2023, at Pragmatics Maidan, New Delhi.The mega Exhibition event was inaugurated and addressed by Hon'ble Prime Minister of india Shri Narendra Modi. We had broadcasted this event through YouTube link, Physically in the College Auditorium.62 faculties and 810 Students Actively participated. They came to know the importance of New Education Policy 2020 and learnt something about Akhil Bhartiya Shiksha Samagam and its activities. Students watched the event on 6<sup>th</sup> August in the same mode.
- 9. The Auxilium Institution's Innovation Council and Department of Mathematics have organized a Seminar on 07.06.2023 at 10:30 am. The lecture in this seminar was given by Chief Guest Prof. Dr. R. Kalaivani, IQAC Coordinator, Head & Asst. Prof. of Bio-Technology, Bon Secours College, Thanjavur. She delivered a lecture on the topic "Sustainable Development Goal Pollution. She explained in detail about the Sustainable Goals in General and in particular about pollution, its disadvantages, and how it affects the human being and the creatures in the world. She further continued, demonstrating the role and the responsibility of each one of us to take care of nature and to safeguard it. It is our whole responsibility to protect nature and eradicate the

pollution in and around us. The responses and the feedback of the participants were good and interesting.

- 10. The World Entrepreneurs Day for start-ups and innovators was organized by the Auxilium Institution Innovation Council of Arts and Science. 32 faculty members participated along with 480 students. Five experts in various fields animated our students and gave them a few ideas on Entrepreneurship. The program had five sessions on the following topics; Smart Personality, Dynamic leadership, Phycological Maturity, Emotional Balance, and Entrepreneurial goal setting. Students benefited from these talks to be smart and creative innovators.
- 11. Under the aegis of AKAM, 'HarGharTiranga' campaign was organized by Auxilium College. Faculties and students conducted an awareness programme to stimulate the feeling of patriotism in the people's heart on 14.08.2023. The faculty members and students of Auxilium College distributed the national flags to all the houses in Ulavayal village and created awareness to the people. Ms. R.Shanthi Head&Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil gave speech on the topic of independence and talked about national leaders and their sacrifices like Mahathma Gandhi, Nethaji Subash Chandrabose, TirupurKumaran and Bhagathsingh. After which the village people have known about the leaders and they took a pledge to commemorate India's independence. Totally 50 members benefitted from this awareness programme.

It was a momentous day for our educative institution as we welcome our esteemed chief guests Mr. Rajendran Head Master, Govt. Middle School, Regunathapuram, and Mr. Manikandan President, Regunathapuram, MsBerneth Mary Soosai, former Chairperson of Regunathapuram, Mr.Dharmaraj, Ex Councillor and President who have graciously accepted our invitation. The programme started with TamilthaiVaazhthu. And then Rev.Sr.Amali hoisted the flag and then the flag song was played. The programme was headed by our Secretary Rev.Sr.Magnificat, our Principal Rev.Sr.Dr.Sebasti Jeya Pushpam, our Vice-Principal Rev.Sr.SantiaguTheresal and all the chief guests. The welcome address was delivered by Ms.Sangeetha Assistant Professor, Department of Tamil. After that, the Chief guests were honoured and felicitated by our Secretary, Principal and Vice-Principal. The stage was decorated with flowers, balloons, and tricolour flags. Various cultural programmes were performed by the students like dance, drama, speech, etc. The total participants were around

- 12. A one-day Faculty Development Programme was organized by Auxilium Institution Innovation Council of Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women, Regunathapuram on 19 June 2023. The main objective of the program is to orient the faculty members to be effective academicians in the following academic year 2023-2024. Sr.Magnificat Soosai, the secretary of the college inaugurated the event, honoring and felicitating the resource person along with Dr. Pushpa, the principal of Auxilium College of Arts and Science, and Dr. Sr. Teresa, the Vice Principal of the college. Rev. Fr.Dr.Arnald Mahesh SDB, Dean of Philosophy, St.Peter's Pontifical Institute, Bangalore was the resource person of the day. He presented a session on 'DYNAMIC LEADERSHIP' for Young Generation. Various case studies were discussed and the skills required were explained.
