

Description	An Anti-Ragging pledge-taking ceremony was held on August 12, 2024, during the morning assembly for all students to promote a safe and respectful campus environment. The session was organized to sensitize students about the anti-ragging rules. The event lasted for half an hour and involved all students taking the pledge. The purpose of the event was to raise awareness among students about the anti-ragging policies and to encourage them to commit to not engaging in any form of ragging or violent behavior. All participants pledged that they would neither indulge in ragging nor tolerate being ragged or subjected to violence. The pledge emphasized the following motives: • Ensuring student safety and well-being • Promoting a healthy academic atmosphere • Fostering respect and dignity • Preventing bullying and harassment • Creating awareness and ensuring legal compliance • Building trust and community • Empowering students for long-term change Pledge on Anti-Ragging: "I promise that I will not indulge in ragging or any form of violent behavior. I will not tolerate being ragged or subjected to violence. I understand that if I am accused of ragging, the responsibility is on me to prove that I am not guilty."

Description	On 30th January 2025, the Department of Mathematics organized an awareness program titled "Ragging-Free Campus: Ensuring Student Safety" at Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women.
