Description	<p>AIDS and Dengue awareness programmes were successfully conducted on 5th October 2024, organized collaboratively by the Red Ribbon Club (RRC), EXNORA, NSS, and the faculty members of our college. The highlight of the day was a grand awareness rally, which was formally inaugurated by our Secretary, Principal, Vice Principal, and faculty members on behalf of the National Welfare Project, RRC, and EXNORA, by ceremoniously waving the green flag. The rally saw the enthusiastic participation of 100 students and 12 professors.</p> <p>The rally commenced at 9:30 a.m. from the college premises. Students carried banners and chanted slogans as they marched through the main roads of Regunathapuram, spreading vital messages to the public.</p> <p>The rally focused on raising awareness about AIDS and Dengue—educating the community about their causes, symptoms, and preventive measures. Students displayed posters urging people to avoid water stagnation, properly dispose of coconut shells, old tyres, and other items that could become mosquito breeding grounds.
