Description	<p>On 05th October 2024, a massive AIDS and Dengue Awareness Rally was organized by Auxilium College of Arts and Science for Women, Regunathapuram, as part of the collaborative initiatives of the Youth Red Cross (YRC), National Service Scheme (NSS), and the Red Ribbon Club (RRC).
