Alfred Cecil Raj, IQAC- Co-Coordinator Department of Physics St. Joseph College, Trichirappalli, Dr. Ordetta Mendoza, Xavier Board Bangalore, Former Head And Professor, Department of Bio-Informatics, Stella Mary's College (Autonomous) Chennai and Dr. Joe Jesudurai Accreditation Ambassador, Former Head and Professor Department of Physics, Loyola College (Autonomous) Chennai were the resource persons in this workshop. The workshop started sharply at 9.30 a.m. with a small prayer song followed by that welcome speech was given by Mrs. M. Julie Assistant Professor Department of Commerce.



#### SESSION - I

Session – I was taken by Dr. Alfred Cecil Raj on the topic of "Institutional Preparedness".

He gave a small introduction about Revised Accreditation Framework, core values, and quality assurance in the institutional levels after he continued the session with the institutional core values preparation how to be documented in "pre-submission, during sub-mission and post-sub-mission. He highlighted the following points that have to be followed in quality assurance and quality enhancement at institutional levels. They are

He differentiated between RAF and prior NAAC assessment models and also he explained some of the new parameters introduced in RAF. Finally, he concluded the session with the support needed for accreditation at the institutional level.

#### **SESSION - II**

Dr. Ordetta Mendoza, who is very resourceful and an expert in academic and administrative audit started her session at 11.30. she presented slides on seven criteria wise key indicators and their weightage for better understanding about Self Study Report preparation, data templates with the necessary information for preparation of document in excel format, formulas for computing percentage, and averages in different cases, what is to be included and is to be avoided in the preparation of SSR. She enriched our faculties in the following key indicators

- Curricular aspects CBCS, elective course system
- Value-added course, certificate course,
- Gender equity program, human values
- Feedback system
- Student enrollment and their profile
- The ratio of students and teachers
- Evaluation process and reforms
- ICT Classrooms Google classroom, smart classes, interactive videos
- Governance
- Reservation of admission
- Best practices mentor and mentees ratio.

#### INTERACTION OF FACULTIES

Our faculties clarified their doubts in the log book and minutes of meetings, reservation of admissions in minority institution, skill-based electives and value added course, the difference between mentor and tutor, what are clubs and cells have to be created, and its members, through this clarification we got clear ideas for the preparation of NAAC.
